What is a SUPA Club?

- A Scripture Union Primary Age (SUPA) Club provides a safe and welcoming place for all students to investigate Christian beliefs and discover hope, life, and purpose.
- SUPA Clubs operate throughout Australia and are run by Scripture Union Australia (SU). SU is a Christian organisation that unites a wide range of Christian churches to work together.
- SU has been working in ACT schools for over 40 years and also runs holiday programs, camps and community activities.
- SUPA Clubs operate in schools during lunchtimes or after school with the permission of the principal and are led by volunteers from local churches.
- SUPA Clubs are welcoming to all students regardless of their beliefs and background. No Christian belief is required or assumed.

What happens at SUPA Club?

SUPA Clubs are fun and interactive. Students explore the Bible through stories, craft, and games. There are plenty of opportunities to make new friends and have the occasional treat.



What is the purpose?

- SUPA clubs are designed to provide a friendly, fun, inclusive, and safe environment for kids to connect to each other, the community, and God. Kids are invited to explore who Jesus is, what the Bible says, and what Christians believe in an age-appropriate manner.
- The curriculum is available should any parent/carer request to know more about what their children are learning. SU programs do not focus on controversial issues and work to promote harmony.
- To provide opportunities for kids to learn to help and care for each other, develop leadership and team skills.

Who are the leaders?

The leaders are all members of local churches who believe that everyone should have the opportunity to investigate Christianity for themselves. Scripture Union Australia oversees the running of the club.

All volunteers are required to complete a strict screening process, which includes a Working with Vulnerable People card, two referees, ChildSafe training, an interview, and ongoing training with SU Australia.



Do children need permission to attend SUPA Club?

- Yes. Children must have permission from a parent or guardian before they are allowed to attend.
- Complete the form online or bring the completed form (see reverse) to school, either to the front office or SUPA Club on the day. This permission will be valid for the duration of the student's time at the school. If a parent or guardian no longer wants their child to attend SUPA Club, please contact the school.
