

2024 Year 5/6 - Borambola Camp

Dear Parents and Carers,

The following details relate to the upcoming camp to Borambola for Years 5 and 6.

Dates & Times	Wednesday 4 th to Friday 6 th September, 2024 (Week 7, Term 3)
Venue & Transport	Coach transport to and from Borambola leaving school at 7.50am on Wednesday 4 th September (arrive no later than 7.40am or 7:15am if you have medications to register) and returning to school 4.30pm on Friday 6 th September (if the bus is delayed we will inform parents via text). Borambola Camp is run by NSW Sport and Recreation and is located 25 min from Wagga Wagga on the Tarcutta River. Camp information can be located at <u>School Camp Venue Borambola</u> (Riverina) - Office of Sport (think-outside.com.au)
Activities/Accommodation	The focus of the camp will be on outdoor activities, which will develop self-confidence and encourage group cohesion and teamwork, cooperation and leadership skills. Activities will be led by Borambola staff and Hawker teachers. Lunch and snacks will be provided for the duration of camp except for recess on the first day. Borambola accommodation is provided in comfortable cabins. Girls and boys are in separate buildings. Teachers will sleep in the rooms between student cabins.
Clothing & Equipment	Warm clothing including jumper/jacket and a sun smart hat. Suitable shoes for participation in outdoor activities (please see the packing list). Lunch all 3 days, dinner, breakfast and snacks will be provided, however students will need to bring a drink bottle (clearly labelled). Please Note: Students will be required to bring recess for the trip to Borambola, which we will eat at the park at Jugiong. Parents are asked to supervise packing, so that other food items do not appear at camp.

Excursion Risk Assessment (including Covid Safe practices): Available at the front office **Behavioural expectations**- Hawker Students are expected to always display our SCARF values when representing the school, this includes school excursions.

Staff accompanying students on excursions will take all reasonable care while the students are in their charge to protect them from injury and to control and supervise their behaviour and activities. Parents should be aware that staff members are not responsible for injuries or damage to property which may occur on an excursion where, in all circumstances, staff have not been negligent. Parents should warn children of the risk to themselves, to others and to property, of impulsive, wilful or disobedient behaviour.

MEDICATION

If your child requires medication while on camp, please arrive at the school hall **at 7.15am** on Wednesday 4th September to hand over medication to the designated first aid officer, **Rachel Eisenberg**, for the camp.

- If your child requires medication, a Medication Authorisation and Administration Record will need to be filled out (available from the front office)
- Medication is to be given to the designated first aid officer for the camp in a <u>labelled</u> zip lock bag with clear instructions in writing about <u>dosage amounts and frequency</u>.
- If your child gets motion sickness, please administer their tablet before coming to school. Don't forget to include a tablet for the return journey and to fill out a Medication Authorisation and Administration Record.

If these requirements are not met, then normal first aid procedures will be followed. This means no medication can be administered, including antihistamines, paracetamol, etc.

If your child suffers from asthma, please ensure that a complete asthma plan is provided to the class teacher in addition to the general medical form. Please contact the designated first aid officer for the camp or the front office if you have any further questions.

Friday 2 nd August –	Camp notes due and medical information due (online). This will allow teachers and Borambola staff to make final arrangements and to accommodate all student needs.
Friday 30 th August –	Final payment due. If you need help with the payment or would like to discuss a payment plan, please contact the front office.
Wednesday 4 th Sept –	7:20-7:40am Arrive at school hall and have your name marked off on the roll. If your child has medication, please see Rachel Eisenberg and arrive at 7:15am.
Friday 6 th September –	4:30pm Arrive back at school. Students to be picked up in the front carpark
